What we Do:

Aid for Haiti seeks out people in Haiti that have not been touched, no matter how remote they are, and cares for them. We began in response to reports of unique diseases coming out of the remote mountains in the southwest of Haiti. We have continued to branch out to care for



the people in remote regions. Here, we staff and supply mobile medical facilities who see thousands of Haitians per week. We strive to go where no others go, well off the paved road, off the well



beaten track, into harder to reach areas. We desire to follow God into whatever need exists in Haiti. We meet the people where they are. Not just on the road near the airport, not just at the end of the road, but also those at the end of the footpath into areas few Americans have ever been. It just takes a

willing heart to seek them out.

Imagine you are on a medical team in Haiti when you examine the 4-year-old, you discover he is indeed seriously ill. In fact, he is dying. What started out as vomiting and diarrhea has now turned into serious dehydration and shock. You work as fast as you can to provide the best care possible, although realizing it is far from the advantages of the

pediatric intensive care unit back in the United States. You gather some of the team around you and pray with the parents for the child. God intervenes, and the boy walks out of the clinic with his parents that evening in good health.

Imagine you are in another village, during your last day of clinic. You are surprised when the patient in front of you is someone you saw two days ago. You ask her why she has returned to the clinic only to find yourself amazed at her reply. "I want to have Jesus as my Savior", she states. She said the care and medicines you

gave her helped her feel better, and that maybe what we said about Jesus being able to help her with her sin was also true! As these stories illustrate, we continue to watch the Lord perform great physical and spiritual miracles in Haiti through our opportunity to serve in medicine.
